INTRODUCTION

This Order is issued in support of a U.S. Government contract. In Sypris Electronics' acceptance of the order from its customer, Sypris has also accepted supplemental clauses to the order commonly referred to as FAR/DFAR's. The substance of the FAR/DFAR clauses ("flow downs") are the requirements passed on to Sypris by its Customer that also apply to any order placed by Sypris in support of that contract. As a valued supplier to Sypris Electronics, LLC, ("Seller") Seller is equally bound by these flow downs above and beyond Sypris' standard terms and conditions. Seller is responsible for thoroughly vetting each requirement internally and, upon periodic audit by Sypris Electronics LLC, demonstrate that Seller fully understands, flows down, and is compliant to each of the clauses that have been flowed down to Seller. Successful compliance is confirmed to Sypris by objective evidence provided to Sypris by Seller.

At any time, if additional clarification is needed on any of the flow downs, contact the Sypris Procurement Representative identified on the Order promptly. Further, if at any time during the performance of the Order Seller becomes aware of a potential or actual breach of any of the clauses provided, Seller is obligated to immediately notify the requisite Sypris Procurement Representative to mitigate any potential risks to timely and fully compliant delivery of the specified Goods and/or Services to Sypris' end Customer.

As used in the clauses referenced below and in this Order, the following definitions shall apply:

1. "Contractor" means Seller.
2. "Commercial Item" means a commercial item as defined in FAR 2.101.
3. "Contract" means this contract, order, or purchase order.
4. "Government"/"Contracting Officer" means Sypris Electronics, LLC and Sypris Electronics, LLC's Contractual Representative. However, the words "Government" and "Contracting Officer" do not change: (1) when a right, act, authorization, or obligation can be granted or performed only by the Government or Prime Contract Contracting Officer or duly authorized representative, (2) when title to the property is to be transferred directly to the Government, and (3) in FAR 52.227-1, 52.227-2, and DFAR 252.227-7013 and 252.227-7014.
5. "Prime Contract" means the contract between Sypris Electronics, LLC and its higher-tier contractor who has a contract with the US Government.
6. "Subcontract" means any contract placed by the Seller or lower-tier subcontractors under this contract.
7. "Subcontractor" means Seller's subcontractor.

INCORPORATION OF FEDERAL ACQUISITION REGULATION (FAR) AND DEFENSE FAR SUPPLEMENT (DFARS) FLOW DOWN CLAUSES AND PROVISIONS

The following Federal Acquisition Regulation ("FAR") and Defense FAR supplemental clauses ("DFARS") as in effect on the date of this purchase order, unless otherwise noted, are incorporated by reference, with the same force and effect as if they were given in full text and are applicable to this Subcontract. The effective version of each clause shall be the version that applies to Sypris Electronics, LLC under its prime contract or higher-tier subcontract. In all cases, the clauses shall be interpreted to apply to Seller as necessary to reflect the position of Seller as a subcontractor to Sypris Electronics to ensure and codify Seller's obligations to Sypris Electronics, and to enable Sypris Electronics to meet its obligations to its customer. Seller shall include/flow down the appropriate FAR/DFAR clauses and provisions as required in any lower-tier subcontract(s).
